H.S.A.sponsored Loggerheads Walk!

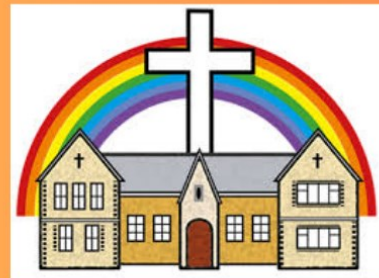
You raised an amazing £766!

and especially Mrs Dobbin for co-ordinating the day. Da iawn pawb!



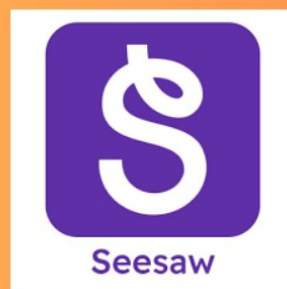
